

## INFORMATION SESSIONS IN DETAIL

### WHAT HAPPENS AFTER VALUE DELIVERY

Rodney Audette, Manager of the Town of White City, will explain what happens after a municipality receives property values, sharing insights from both administration and ratepayer perspectives.

### LOOKING AHEAD TO THE 2029 REVALUATION

Preliminary work for the 2029 Revaluation is well underway, and the next revaluation will have a base date of January 1, 2027. Preparing for the 2029 Revaluation includes consultations, research, publication reviews, and the updating of all our valuation models. This session will look at how the Agency is planning and preparing for the next revaluation in the province.

### TECHNOLOGY UPDATE

Technology continues to play a larger role in how SAMA does our work. Whether it's utilizing Geographic Information System (GIS) technology to create, manage, analyze, and map all types of data, or exploring the role of AI in assessment, SAMA is constantly looking to improve and use technology smartly and efficiently to provide for our clients and stakeholders. This session will outline some of the short- and long-term technology goals SAMA is planning for, and how they will impact our municipal clients and the province.

### Q&A SESSION

This Q&A session will provide delegates with a venue to ask questions and make comments to the SAMA Board on any assessment related matter that they would like to bring forward for the Board's consideration and response. The Board is interested in hearing your views about any topics related to the assessment system in Saskatchewan, which could include the 2029 Revaluation, SAMA's 2026-2029 business plans or the future of assessment in the province. SAMA will be utilizing Slido technology, which will allow delegates to submit questions for the Board from their devices during the annual meeting, as well as being able to ask questions directly from the floor.

## VOTING REGULATIONS

Upon payment of any fee required, each municipal council may register two (2) voting delegates to attend the annual meeting. There is no requirement that the voting representative(s) from a municipality needs to be an elected representative. Municipalities are welcome to appoint an elected or non-elected person from their jurisdiction as their voting representative(s).

A voting delegate must be named in advance of the meeting as a designated voting delegate. A voting delegate must declare their voting status at the time of registration, confirming that they have been appointed by their municipal council to attend the SAMA Annual Meeting as a voting delegate.

Other local government officials and non-elected representatives may be appointed by the council as non-voting participants. They may participate in discussions, but do not have voting privileges.

There is no proxy voting.

Virtual attendees to the Annual Meeting are not allowed to vote.

## ADMINISTRATOR TRAINING SESSION
